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Duty Of Care Statement

The Mater Christi Catholic Community has a Duty of Care to the children attending the Parish Religious Education Programme on advertised Wednesdays during the school term. The children's safety and well-being are most important, and we seek your support and cooperation in upholding our conditions of participation.

We therefore advise you that:

*	Classes commence 3:45pm and conclude 4:45pm	
*	Children supervised only from 3:40pm to 4:50pm	
*	It is a parental responsibility to deliver children on time and sign them in	
*	It is a parental responsibility to collect children on time and sign them out	
*	An older sibling of the child attending PREP classes does not suffice as adequate supervision or validate signing in or signing out of the class (unless over 18 years old and prior arrangements have been made).	
*	The Signing In and Out Form is used in the event of an emergency and failure to sign this form may put your child(ren) at risk.	
*	The Signing In and Out Form is used to check children's attendance. If there are 3 consecutive weeks that your child has not attended, with no prior notification, their enrolment may be withdrawn and their ability to receive their sacrament within that year may be jeopardised.	
*	If you are unable to collect your child(ren) you must nominate authorised people on the blue enrolment form. Catechists are not permitted to release children to any unauthorised person.	
*	As a safety precaution we ask that the signage in the carpark be strictly followed. No children should be unsupervised in the carpark.	
*	If your child(ren) is unable to attend class, parents have a responsibility to contact the Catechist Coordinator on 0439 357 459 . Please <u>do not</u> phone parish office / presbytery number.	

Our Catechist and Sacrament Coordinators, as well as our Catechists, are well-trained volunteers who are from our Parish, Mater Christi. They all have families and/or other commitments prior to and after classes each week. They are not necessarily qualified teachers. Our primary focus is assisting you to help your children to better know God's love and teachings through our Parish Religious Education Programme.
