## An **AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED)** is now available inside the church.

We have recently installed a defibrillator for use in an emergency when someone has stopped breathing. If those assisting commence CPR immediately, while another calls 000, and another quickly accesses and fits the defibrillator, this maximizes the chances the collapsed person will have of a successful recovery. The defibrillator can be fitted and used, if necessary, by untrained people as when it is switched on it provides instructions and confirmation verbal effectiveness of the pads attachment, tells whether defibrillation is necessary and prompts those helping by giving step by step instructions, timing and effectiveness of chest compressions and gives feedback as to what needs to be done until an ambulance arrives.

The defibrillator is kept in a cabinet in the Servers Sacristy alongside our new First Aid Kit. An instructional video is available for viewing should you be interested in seeing how the defib operates, by accessing: http://mbf.cc/tAVKCG.
