REMINDER REGARDING RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION DURING MASS

Whilst we are still in Stage 4 restrictions and obliged by law to observe Physical Distancing rules (ie **1.5m space**
between those who do not reside together), please remember to observe ...

- **Follow the yellow arrows on the floor when queuing for Communion.**
- **Everyone in the main body of the church including those sitting on pews along the walls at the side are to filter into the middle aisle for Communion – do not move across to the wings.**
- **The only people to receive from the Special Ministers when they are standing over at the ‘wings’ of the church are those are sitting in those two areas.** These 2 Special Ministers then move towards the centre aisle to assist the priest and acolyte with the distribution of Communion.
- **There should be no ‘passing’ of people in any of the church aisles.**

Parishioners are still *strongly encouraged* to receive Communion on the hand, however should you wish to
receive Communion on the tongue please approach only the priest toward the end of the distribution.

We appreciate your continued understanding and co-operation at this time that we are required to comply with
these restrictions.

**Should you require a Eucharistic Minister to bring Communion to you in your seat, please notify the
Facilitator of your Mass prior to the commencement of Mass so this can be arranged. You will be
requested to sit on the end of an aisle for ease of access to you.**

Thank you to the dozen or so people who have so generously come forward to volunteer to help with
Ministries during Masses, your assistance is greatly accepted and appreciated. **We are still accepting
more volunteers – ANYTIME** – please contact the Parish Office during the week either by phone or email.
