This weekend we have the **3rd week of our First Reconciliations**, please remember to keep them, their families and teachers in your prayers as these children continue their Sacramental journey.

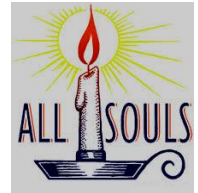


Please remember to keep in your thoughts and prayers, those students whose names are on the list in the foyer who are completing their **WACE Exams** over the next few weeks.
