The Archdiocese is therefore seeking to appoint the following two positions to assist with the transition:

Planning, Risk & Reporting Manager (12 month, full time, fixed term Contract) Role Profile: The position is for an individual with substantial experience in Programme Office functions with specific abilities to deliver programme and project plans, reporting and a common approach to risk management.
